#### WHAT IS THIS COURSE ABOUT?

This course emphasizes learning through practice; building on what students know; and introducing them to new ideas, materials and processes for artistic thinking and experimentation. Student learning will include the application of the elements and principles of design, incorporating the creative design process, the relationship between form and content. Students will also learn about the connections between their works of art and historical artwork in context.

#### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

#### **Units of Instruction:**

- 1. **<u>Drawing Styles:</u>** A drawing portrait study and a high contrast portrait study of a famous person
- 2. **Acrylic Painting:** Student directed content and design using the theory of the Six Colour Combinations
- 3. **Optical Art:** Black and White ink design to explore optics and illusions
- 4. Clay Sculpture: Clay reconstruction of a Medieval image using the theme of Angels & Demons
- 5. **Printmaking:** Celtic design relief block print
- 6. <u>Mixed Media:</u> The final studio summative project emphasizing the use of mixed media to recreate an illuminated letter design.

- Preparation and process work
